Registration is required for meal planning purposes.



Reverend Michael Griffin was born in Aberdeen, SD where he graduated from Aberdeen Central High School in 1981. He graduated from SDSU in 1985 with degrees in journalism and history. After graduation, he was editor of "The Pennington County Courant," in Wall, SD.

Fr. Griffin attended the Saint Paul Seminary School of Divinity of the University of St. Paul and was ordained a Roman Catholic priest for the Diocese of Sioux Falls in 1990. Since his ordination, he has served in parishes in Pierre, Sioux Falls, Brookings and Aberdeen. He was the director of the SDSU Newman Center, taught at O'Gorman High School in Sioux Falls and was editor of the diocesan newspaper. The monastic brothers of Blue Cloud Abbey received his oblation to the Rule of St. Benedict in February 2003. Fr. Griffin was sworn into the South Dakota Army National Guard as a chaplain in November 2009 and served until December 2017. He was activated for Operation Enduring Freedom and served a deployment to Afghanistan in 2013 with the 152nd CSSB SDARNG. He is currently the pastor of the Catholic parishes in Mobridge, Herreid, Eureka, Selby, Ipswich, Leola, Bowdle and Roscoe (the Pastorate of the Visitation).
